

## Plant Operator – AECO STORAGE FACILITIES

### Niska Gas Storage Partners LLC

Niska is the largest independent owner and operator of natural gas storage in North America, with strategically located assets in key natural gas producing and consuming regions. Niska owns and operates three facilities, including the AECO Hub(TM) in Alberta, Canada; Wild Goose in California; and Salt Plains in Oklahoma. Niska also contracts gas storage capacity on the Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America system. In total, Niska owns or contracts approximately 204.5 Bcf of gas storage capacity.

The AECO Suffield Gas Storage facility is located in southeastern Alberta near Medicine Hat. The facility consists of inlet separation, line heaters, dehydration, hydrocarbon dewpoint control, gas compression, large capacity pipeline and well operations.

#### Summary

This position will be based at the Suffield facility and will be responsible for ensuring the safe, reliable and efficient operation of Gas Storage facilities and field.

#### Duties

##### Position Description

Reporting to the Production Coordinator, Suffield, the incumbent will work in a team environment within the Gas Storage team.

##### Duties and Responsibilities

- Operate equipment and facilities in a safe and efficient manner.
- Troubleshoot and repair process problems and identify opportunities for improvement and optimization.
- Monitor and control plant and field processing conditions utilizing SCADA control systems.
- Monitor and optimize gas well and pipeline operations.
- Maintain superior housekeeping standards throughout the plant process and control room areas.
- Responsible for minor maintenance and the coordination of other maintenance activities.
- Understands and performs safety responsibilities such as hazard identification, equipment lockout, emergency response, implement safe work procedures, etc.
- Ensure compliance with environmental and safety regulatory requirements. Responsible for corrective action if required.
- Ensure effective communication with operations, maintenance and management staff.
- Maintain proper documentation including operator log, maintenance records, and safety and environment reports.
- Ongoing performance improvement including job progression, site-specific training, process training, Solis training, etc.
- Willing to work extra hours and be on call as required.

#### REQUIREMENTS

- must reside within one hour of the plant site
- self-motivated, hands-on person
- grade 12 diploma
- Valid class 5 driver license
- 3+ years gas processing experience or equivalent.

- Demonstrated ability to learn new process, operations and have strong problem solving skills.
- Operational and maintenance experience in gas compression, dehydration, pipelines, gas well equipment and hydrocarbon dewpoint control equipment.
- A basic understanding of well performance and reservoir behavior.
- Team player with strong interpersonal, organizational and communication skills required.
- Ability and confidence to work with minimal supervision.
- Self motivated with a strong work ethic and is open to take on a variety of operational challenges.
- Proficient in the use of PC programs specifically in Word, Excel, PVR and Outlook would be an asset.
- The work schedule may vary depending on operational needs.
